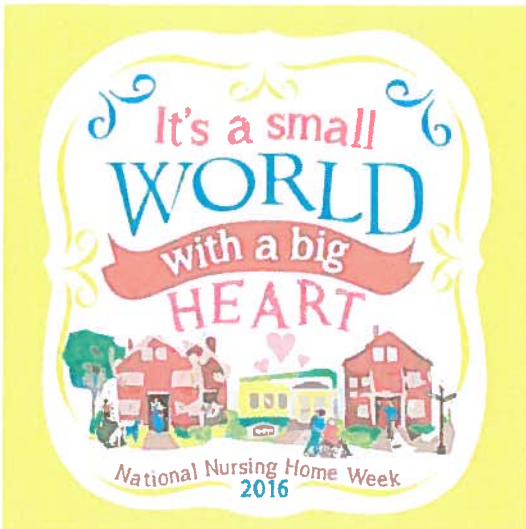
National Nursing Home Week

More Laundry Choices for your Loved Ones



Here at Maunalani, we strive to provide your loved ones with exceptional service in all areas ---including the laundering of clothes.

Here are some choices to consider regarding the care of your loved one's personal clothing:

Option 1:

Maunalani can continue to launder your loved one's personal clothing. However, please keep in mind that the your loved one's clothing is not laundered separately from others.

Option 2:

You may bring your loved one's clothing home to be laundered by you/family.

Option 3

You may launder the clothes **HERE at Maunalani.**
Starting this month, **2 washer/dryer sets are available to use on the 2nd floor.**

This is a complimentary service---no charge to you.
You will only have to provide your own detergent.



TIP #1

Please label your loved one's clothing. Black and metallic laundry markers are available for you to use. Permanent labelers can also be used. Please ask our caregivers for assistance.

Please Note: For dignity purposes, please **DO NOT** label the clothes on the outside for all to see/read.

TIP #2

When you bring in any new clothes for your loved one, please let his/her caregiver know so that our team members can update the inventory list.

TIP #3

You may bring a mesh bag to be used for laundering your loved one's socks, underwears, lingerie. Please work with our caregivers to help you label the mesh bag.

TIP #4

Shrinkage of your loved one's clothing may occur due to the high heat of our Industrial-size dryer. You are welcome to bring home sensitive clothing (i.e. sweaters, satin, silk) to launder. If this is your desire, please communicate with your loved one's caregiver.
